Formulas List for the TCM**

On the Clinical Case Studies exam, Herbology questions make up 7-10% of your exam. If there are say 6-8 case studies on the exam each with 6 questions, then the number of herbology questions will be around 3-5 questions total. This is not a lot of questions. The best advice I can give is to keep it simple. Use the most obvious well-known formulas and herbs. Don't try to get fancy with modifications or using obscure formulas even if they are on your formula list.

The formulas on this list are suggestions. This is TCM Herbology, so the sky is the limit in the formulas and modifications that you can use for each Disease pattern. My approach is to keep it simple. These are the most straight-forward highly recognized formulas and modifications. Where there is not a clear formula for a disease pattern, I have put N/A. Chances of you being asked herbology questions for these disease patterns is not very likely. Remember at most you will have 3-5 questions total on your exam for herbology.

As always with short-answer exams, keep it simple, clear and succinct!
